- Assist with environmental assessments, environmental site assessments, contaminated sites, remediation, and environmental monitoring initiatives.
- Review environmental reports, studies, assessments, and consultant recommendations.
- Support environmental components of Additions to Reserve, land acquisition, development, and infrastructure projects.
- Coordinate with First Nations, Indigenous Services Canada, federal and provincial departments, environmental consultants, municipalities, and other partners.
- Support community engagement, meetings, workshops, training, and environmental capacity-building initiatives.
- Provide general administrative and project support to the USKE team.

Qualifications

- Experience in environmental assessment, monitoring, contaminated sites, land management, or environmental project coordination is an asset.
- Knowledge of federal and provincial environmental legislation and regulatory processes is an asset.
- Experience working with First Nations governments, communities, or Indigenous organizations is strongly preferred.
